BE IT RESOLVED that the Board approves the elimination of correspondence received without the inclusion of who is submitting the correspondence being read aloud at the village board meetings.

MULHOLLAND/LAZARONY

WHEREAS, the Chief of Police intends to prefer disciplinary charges against an employee of the Village Police Department pursuant to Section 75 of the New York State Civil Service law; and

WHEREAS, Section 75(2) of the Civil Service Law authorizes the Board to designate a deputy or other person to conduct the hearing upon said charges; and

WHEREAS the Board desires to appoint an independent and qualified individual to serve as the hearing officer to conduct the hearing, review the evidence, make findings of fact, and issue a recommendation to the Board for its review and determination; and now, therefore, it is hereby

RESOLVED, that the Board hereby designates and appoints Brian Doyle, Esq. to serve as the hearing officer pursuant to Section 75 of the New York State Civil Service Law, and to be vested with all powers and duties as prescribed by Section 75 of the Civil Service law, including but not limited to hearing evidence, making a transcript of the proceedings; and issuing a written report of his findings and recommendations to the Board for its review and decision in connection with the charges to be preferred; and be it further

RESOLVED, that the hearing officer shall be compensated for their services at the rate of \$225 per hour, plus reasonable and necessary expenses.

LAZARONY/MULHOLLAND

WHEREAS, certain allegations regarding a particular employee of the Village Police Department have been brought to the Board's attention; and

WHEREAS, the Chief of Police has investigated the matter and reported on same to the Board in executive session, and intends to pursue disciplinary charges against said employee under Section 75 of the New York State Civil Service Law; and now, therefore, it is hereby

RESOLVED, that the Board hereby authorizes the Chief of Police to take any and all necessary disciplinary action against said employee, including, but not limited to preferring, executing and serving disciplinary charges and assisting with the disciplinary hearing; and be it further

RESOLVED, that the Board hereby authorizes the Chief of Police to suspend said employee without pay immediately upon delivery of charges upon him, in accordance with Section 75 of the Civil Service Law.

J. Rules for Public Comment

Public comment shall be conducted according to the following rules:

- Any member of the public may speak about Village business, an agenda item, or another matter reasonably within the authority of the Village government.
- The Village Clerk shall make a speaker sign-up sheet available before the meeting. Speakers who have signed up shall ordinarily be recognized in the order listed, followed by any other person wishing to speak. A person shall not be denied the opportunity to speak solely because the person did not sign up before the meeting began.
- Each speaker shall be allowed up to three minutes. The same time limit shall be applied equally to all speakers. Time may not be transferred from one speaker to another.
- Each person may speak once during the public comment period unless the presiding officer permits additional comment for purposes of clarification.
- Comments shall be addressed to the Board as a whole. Public comment is an opportunity for the Board to receive information and viewpoints and is not ordinarily a question-and-answer session. The Mayor, a Trustee, or an appropriate Village official may briefly clarify a factual matter or arrange for follow-up when appropriate.
- Speakers may criticize Village policies, decisions, operations, employees, or elected officials. A speaker shall not be interrupted or ruled out of order merely because the Board disagrees with the speaker's viewpoint or because the comments are critical, uncomfortable, or unpopular.
- Conduct that materially disrupts the meeting is prohibited. Examples include shouting over another recognized speaker, refusing to stop after the allotted time has expired, making a threat of violence, blocking access within the meeting room, or otherwise preventing the Board or the public from hearing or proceeding with the meeting.

- Before directing a speaker to stop or leave the meeting, the presiding officer shall ordinarily identify the rule being violated and provide a reasonable warning and opportunity to comply. Immediate action may be taken when reasonably necessary to address an actual threat or protect the safety of those present.
- These rules shall be administered in a viewpoint-neutral and consistent manner. No person shall receive preferential or unfavorable treatment based upon the person's identity, political position, support for or criticism of the Village, or relationship with a member of the Board
