

PROCEDURE FOR NEW ELECTRICAL LICENSE FOR VILLAGE OF FREDONIA

YOU MUST SUBMIT:

- **Completed application for Electrical License**
- **Application fee:** Fee for a new license is \$150. *Check made out to 'Village of Fredonia'*
- **Insurance forms:** MUST BE CURRENT AND MUST NAME THE **ELECTRICIAN** OR **ELECTRICAL CONTRACTOR**
 - NYS Liability Insurance, for the electrician or electrical contractor
 - NYS Disability Insurance (form DB120.1)
 - NYS Worker's Comp (form C-105.2 or CE-200)
- **Copy of your current Electrical License(s) for a municipality as large as or larger than Village of Fredonia**
- **Proof of taking and passing the ICC Master's Electrician Exam**

ADDITIONALLY, YOU MUST BE:

- **Familiar and up-to-date with present utility electrical specification for installation in the Village of Fredonia**

Once all of the above documents are submitted, the Electrical Board will review them. If/when your application is approved, you will be notified and the license will be sent to you via mail.
