PROCEDURE FOR NEW ELECTRICAL LICENSE FOR VILLAGE OF FREDONIA

YOU MUST SUBMIT:

- <u>Completed application for Electrical License</u>
- <u>Application fee:</u> Fee for a new license is \$150. Check made out to 'Village of Fredonia'
- Insurance forms: MUST BE <u>CURRENT</u> AND MUST NAME THE
 <u>ELECTRICIAN</u> OR <u>ELECTRICAL CONTRACTOR</u>
 - NYS Liability Insurance, for the electrician or electrical contractor
 - NYS Disability Insurance (form DB120.1)
 - NYS Worker's Comp (form C-105.2 or CE-200)
- <u>Copy of your current Electrical License(s) for a municipality as</u> <u>large as or larger than Village of Fredonia</u>
- Proof of taking and passing the ICC Master's Electrician Exam

ADDITIONALLY, YOU MUST BE:

• Familiar and up-to-date with present utility electrical specification for installation in the Village of Fredonia

Once all of the above documents are submitted, the Electrical Board will review them. If/when your application is approved, you will be notified and the license will be sent to you via mail.
