WHEREAS, Proposed Local Law No. 5 of 2025, has been prepared and submitted to the Village Board of Trustees to consider for adoption; and

WHEREAS, Proposed Local Law No. 5 of 2025 would establish chapter 198 of the Village of Fredonia Code entitled "A Local Law Establishing Chapter 198 of the Village of Fredonia Code Entitled Vendors" and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 20 of the Municipal Home Rule Law of the State of New York, a public hearing was duly held on Monday April 28, 2025 and all parties in attendance were permitted an opportunity to speak in support of or in opposition to said proposed Local Law, or any part thereof; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees of the Village of Fredonia, after due deliberation, finds it in the best interest of the Village to adopt said Local Law, now, therefore

BE IT RESOLVED, the Village of Fredonia hereby adopts said Local Law as Local Law No. 5 of 2025 entitled, "A Local Law Establishing Chapter 198 of the Village of Fredonia Code Entitled Vendors", a copy of which is attached hereto and made a part hereof; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, the Village of Fredonia Clerk is hereby directed to enter said Local Law in the minutes of this meeting and in the Local Law Book of the Village of Fredonia, and to give due notice of the adoption of said Local Law to the Secretary of State by filing the same with the Secretary of State as required by law.

Chapter 198

Vendors

**§198-1 Definitions.**

The Board shall determine, by resolution, any additional restrictions on vendors which it reasonably believes are necessary to protect the public safety and the interests of other proprietors within the Village.

**§ 198-6. Appeals.**

Any applicant, having been denied a license to vend, may appeal said decision to the Board of Trustees, who will then grant or deny such appeal.

**§ 198-7. Violations and penalties.**

Each violation of this chapter shall be punishable by a fine not exceeding \$250 for each offense or by imprisonment for a period not to exceed 15 days, or by both such fine and imprisonment. Such violation may also serve as grounds to revoke a license issued pursuant to this chapter, as well as the denial of future licensing.

**§ 198-8. Severability.**

If any provisions of this chapter, including any exception, part, phrase or term or any application thereof to any person or circumstances, are held invalid, the application to other persons or circumstances shall not be affected thereby and the validity of this chapter in any and all other respects shall not be affected thereby.

**§ 198-9. Records to be kept.**

The Code Enforcement Officer shall cause to be kept in his office an accurate record of every application received and acted upon, together with all other information and data pertaining thereto and all licenses issued under the provisions of this chapter, and of the denial of applications. Applications for licenses shall be numbered in consecutive order as filed, and every license issued and any renewal thereof shall be identified with the duplicate number of the application upon which it was issued.

**§ 198-10. Licenses not to be issued to certain persons.**

No license shall be issued to any person who has been convicted of a crime under the laws of the state or any other state or federal law of the United States within five (5) years of the date of the application nor to any person who has been convicted of a violation of any of the provisions of this chapter nor to any person whose license issued hereunder has previously been revoked as herein provided.

**§ 198-11. Revocation of license.**

A. Any license issued hereunder shall be revoked by the Code Enforcement Officer if the holder of the license is convicted of a violation of any of the provisions of this chapter or has made a false material statement in the application or otherwise becomes disqualified for the issuance of a license under the terms of this chapter. Immediately upon such revocation, written notice thereof shall be given by the Code Enforcement Officer to the holder of the license in person or by certified United States mail addressed to his or her residence address set forth in the application.

B. Immediately upon the giving of such notice, the license shall become null and void.

**§ 198-12. Expiration date.**

The license shall state the expiration date thereof.

**§ 198-13. Duration of license.**

A. The period of time for which the license shall be valid shall be as set forth by resolution of the Board of Trustees.

B. In determining the expiration date of the license, the day that the license is issued shall count as the first day.

**§ 198-14. Exemptions.**

Sales by persons under the age of 18 years, and any other activity whereby the vendor, has been previously invited by the occupant shall be exempt from this chapter. Religious corporations, and persons under the age of 18 years shall be exempt from the license requirement of this chapter. Any public market or farmer's

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- A. Grantor agrees that Grantee may provide PEG Channel programming to Subscribers utilizing switched digital video.
- B. Grantor demonstrates the ability to produce all of its PEG Channel programming in HD.
- C. Grantor enters into a separate commercial contract for services with Grantee's commercial services group that will govern the terms, conditions and costs for the construction (where necessary), transmission, maintenance, and monitoring of the HD signal from Grantor's origination point to Grantee's headend or hub site. To the extent the Grantor is not in a separate commercial contract with Grantee's commercial services group for HD PEG Channel transport, Grantee's obligation to carry the HD PEG Channel shall cease until a new commercial contract with Grantee's commercial services group for HD PEG Channel transport is in place.

**13.3. Replacement of PEG Channel.** Grantee shall, within one (1) year of all the conditions set forth in Section 13.2 above being met, make available one (1) PEG Channel in HD format to Grantor (the "HD PEG Channel"). The HD PEG Channel will replace the existing PEG Channel described in Section 13.1 and will not be in addition to the current PEG Channel.

**13.4. PEG Support.**

Within ninety (90) days of the Effective Date, Grantee shall provide to Grantor a capital grant of \$6,500 to be used by the Grantor solely for capital costs, including capital maintenance, by Grantor, or its designated PEG administrator, for PEG access facilities, and which are treated as capital costs under GAAP. Grantee may pass through such capital grant to Subscribers in accordance with applicable law. In addition, no sooner than the fifth (5th) anniversary of the Effective Date and upon written request of the Grantor, Grantee will begin collecting eleven cents (\$.11) per Subscriber per month and remitting same to Grantor by March 31 of each year for the previous calendar year (or portion thereof), to be used by the Grantor to purchase PEG access production replacement or supplement equipment, and which are treated as capital costs under GAAP. This pass-through shall be reduced or terminated at any time upon request of the Grantee and shall terminate no later than ten (10) years after the Effective Date. Upon receipt of a written request from Grantee, the Grantor shall provide Grantee with a complete accounting of the use of all funds for the prior calendar year granted pursuant to this Section 13.4. Any grant funds used for non-PEG capital purposes are subject to offset from the franchise fee in accordance with applicable law.

**13.5. PEG Competitive Neutrality.** Any PEG access channel designation requirements set forth in any other cable television franchise in the Village of Fredonia shall not be different than the channel designation requirements required under this franchise, and any provisions for PEG access facilities, equipment and support in such other franchise shall be competitively neutral when compared to this Franchise.





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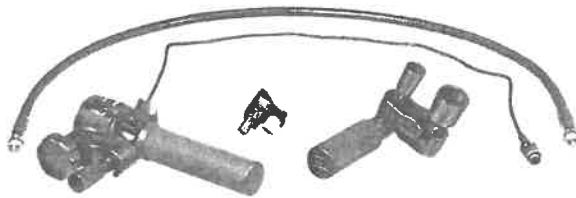
